Dear Parents/Carers

Just a final note before the Iceland trip to remind you of some crucial details. We leave from the school car park on Saturday 7th of April at 7.45am. Please be there at 7.30am sharp. We will return to the school car park on Wednesday 11th April at approximately 2.30pm. Please double check that your daughter brings both her passport and European Health Insurance Card.

All students need to come with a towel and swimming costume packed in hand luggage as we will go straight to the Blue Lagoon when we arrive; it is a refreshing start to the trip! No liquids or other prohibited goods please. All students should bring any medical equipment that will be required for the duration of the trip in their hand luggage e.g. inhalers, epipens etc.

All electronic devices, including mobile phones need to be fully charged for the flight.

Students will need cash for the airport but please remember it is a cashless system on board the plane. I estimate that they will need approximately £40 in Icelandic Krona for use in Iceland.

Unfortunately, the room allocations have not yet been released from the hotels, these are expected 2-3 days prior to departure. I have assured students that I will do everything I can to ensure that they are sharing a room with at least one person that they know and can only apologise that this cannot be organised prior to leaving for Iceland.

Can I reiterate that should you need to contact your child about anything serious during the trip please do contact me first, thus enabling me and the accompanying staff to provide students with appropriate pastoral care if necessary. Of course we hope that such an eventuality will not occur.
