

Dear parents,

Firstly, I am writing to inform you that we are making a slight change to the current school uniform in September. The regulation school skirt was introduced at the start of this academic year and had a minimum length of 18 inches. Any shorter varieties are not permitted. For the coming September, we have added a logo to this skirt. I would therefore ask when you buy a new skirt for your daughter that it has the logo on it. This regulation skirt with the logo is available at both uniform shops in Skipton. It is permissible for your daughter to continue wearing the correct skirt from this year without the logo but once you decide to replace it, please purchase the new logo-embroidered skirt.

Secondly, during the warm weather we are experiencing this week I have had several requests from students for them to remove their tights. Please be aware that they have not been allowed to do this but to ensure they are more comfortable whilst the warm weather continues, they are allowed to wear a lower denier of tights.
