**Data and Examinations 2020 -21 - Key Dates for Year 13**

It has been lovely to see the Year 13 students back at school this half-term. Please find below key assessment and reporting dates for students this academic year. Students will sit Year 13 Trial Exams in early February and further details about these will be sent out nearer the time.

During the year we plan to send out two written reports and hold a parents' evening to keep you informed of the progress pupils are making. Teachers have been and will continue to assess student performance in a variety of ways and use this assessment to report a current prediction of the grade they feel students are most likely to get at the end of Year 13. They will also report on students' commitment to learning as well.

As you may have seen in the news A-Level examinations have been moved back by about three weeks this year and the A-Level results day has changed too. Where any alterations have been made to students' curricula by exam boards teachers will make sure they adapt their teaching to take account of this. Further details of any changes can be found on exam board websites. The university application process should continue as normal.
