Monday 8th March LFD Testing

- Your child should arrive at their allocated time and make their way to the marquee where they will be met by members of staff.
- Please ensure that your child does not eat 30 minutes before their allocated testing time.
- It would help us enormously if all students in Y10 (not Y7) with a smart phone were able to set up an account to register their test prior to the testing day. This will reduce the registration time greatly Please use the link below:

- Any students unable to do this will be able to register with a member of staff.
- Your child will then be directed to the Testing Site, which is in the Studio.
- Following the test your child is free to go home, the whole process should take no longer than 30 minutes.
- Your child does not need to wear school uniform for testing.

LFD testing is one of the ways that will help minimise any potential transmission and further disruption to students' learning. Our other safety measures including social distancing, wearing masks, washing hands/hand sanitising will remain in place until further notice.

Whilst we strongly encourage participation in LFD testing, it is not compulsory and students whose parents do not consent for testing will be able to return to school for face-to-face teaching at the same time as their peers.
